Regular Meeting

June 10, 2021

The meeting was called to order at the Township Hall located at 135 Elm Street, Burlington, MI 49029 at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Eyre with a total of 23 people in attendance. After the Pledge, roll was taken with Jeff Eyre, Darlene Mack, Barton Boyer and Susan Mack present, Jeanette Demski was absent. **Public Comment Time** – Was opened at 6:31 p.m. and closed at 6:56 p.m. Concerns shared – widening of O Dr. S. with trees in ditches being scrapped around, culvert covered, large rocks in road way, large truck traffic moving very fast. Carol Adams requested agenda time for July to discuss decorations on cemetery graves. Complaint regarding the property at 1627 Case Dr. & 9 Mile Rd. house is not occupied and rodents are invading neighboring properties, the Beautification Ordinance will allow the zoning administrator to respond to this complaint. Ernest Foster stated he will be circulating a petition to have the Township Beautification Ordinance repealed. **Approval of Minutes** – **Motion** by S. Mack, 2nd by Eyre and carried to approve the meeting minutes from the May 27, 2021 special meeting. **Treasurer's Financial Reports** – were received. **Payment of Bills** – **Motion** by Boyer, 2nd by S. Mack and carried to approve payment of bills totaling \$20,566.08. **Committee Reports: Road Committee** – has not met. **Zoning Administrator's Report** – Paul Walker's written report was provided to the board for review. **Land Divisions: #169** for Steven Steury on parcel # 05-104-009-04 was approved with a **motion** by D. Mack, 2nd by Boyer and carried. **#170** for David Hasty on parcel # 05-134-003-00 was approve with a **motion** by Boyer, 2nd by D. Mack and carried. **Fire Chief's Report** - Chief Yeakey's written report was provided to the board for review. **Supervisor's Report** – none. **County Commissioner's Report** – Commissioner Miller was not in attendance. **Building Committee** – none. **Planning Commission Chair's Report** – none. **Old Business:** None. **New Business: Hiring of Clean Up Contractor** – **Motion** by D. Mack (when this motion was made Ernest Foster stated to D. Mack that he would remember this), 2nd by S. Mack (when this motion was seconded Ernest Foster stated to S. Mack that he would remember this) to approve the American Towing Bids for property clean up at 2450 6 ½ Mile Rd (\$4,500.00) and 3725 12 Mile Rd (\$1,500.00), motion was unanimously defeated with the request to have the zoning administrator get at least one additional bid for each property clean-up for price comparison. **Return to Gravel Policy and Procedure** – **Motion** by Eyre, 2nd by Boyer and carried to accept the policy and both petitions as presented. **Planning Commission Appointment** – **Motion** by Eyre, 2nd by D. Mack and carried (with S. Mack abstaining since Turner Waters is her nephew) to appoint Spencer Vahs to the Township Planning Commission, with Turner Waters as an alternate Planning Commission member with voting rights when another member is absent from a meeting. Turner was asked to attend all Planning Commission meetings and will be paid at the same rate as the other members for those meetings he attends. **Township Hall Library Parking Lot** – **Motion** by D. Mack, 2nd S. Mack and carried to have Eyre get bids for parking lot repair to review at July meeting. **Meeting adjournment** by Supervisor Eyre at 7:21 p.m.
